### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

In partnership with Butler County Community College (BC3), the program grants students access to the best of both schools – an excellent, Christ-centered liberal arts and sciences education at Grove City College and accredited, high-quality clinical and professional training at BC3.

# MAJOR

#### Nursing

The Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing prepares students to launch into an impactful career marked by excellent care and compassion. Students take vocation-enriching core humanities courses woven into an academic schedule that will cultivate greater empathy, critical thinking, writing and communication skills, and a deep-rooted appreciation for the dignity of all people.

## **PROGRAM STRUCTURE**

Year 1: Attend Grove City College full-time. Take pre-nursing and core humanities courses and start building community on campus.

Year 2: Attend Grove City College part-time. Take formal nursing classes at Butler County Community College (BC3) and gain hands-on clinical experience through professional placements.

Year 3: Attend Grove City College part-time. Take additional nursing classes at BC3 and gain further hands-on clinical experience through professional placements. Take the State Boards of Nursing exam and earn RN licensure at the conclusion of this year.

Year 4: Attend Grove City College full-time with a flexible course schedule that allows the student to work part-time and "earn while you learn" to finish the BSN degree.
