May 13, 2011 at 4:00 p.m.	Baccalaureate and Commencement Rehearsal (PLC Arena – Rain or shine)
7:00 p.m.	Baccalaureate
May 14, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.	Commencement Lunch open to guests at \$9.45 per person (tickets available for purchase on-line beginning April 11, 2011).

- Baccalaureate and Commencement are to convene on the Quad. In the case of rain, both will be held in the PLC Arena and simulcast to the IM room (for those in overflow seating). All graduates will be issued **four** tickets per event to be used only if the events are held in the PLC Arena. Tickets will be placed in student mailboxes on May 4, 2011. Prayer for sunny weather may begin today.
- As outlined in the letter parents and guardians received in July, a number of local hotel rooms have been blocked under “Grove City College Parents for Graduation” for the evening of Friday, May 13th. Please encourage your family to make reservations as soon as possible. On-campus housing will not be available for those attending the Commencement weekend.
