## **Chef and director of student health services planning cookbook signing/recipe tasting at County Market**

GROVE CITY, Pa. – Grove City College Director of Student Health Services Karen Danielson will sign copies of her cookbook, “Creations and Collections from KD’s Kitchen,” from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Jan. 26 at County Market in Grove City.

Danielson will also make recipes from the cookbook for consumers to taste. Dishes at the Jan. 26 signing will be heart-healthy and have a Super Bowl theme. Copies of Danielson’s cookbook, which contains more than 250 heart-healthy recipes, will be on sale for \$12.50. One recipe, “Heart-Healthy Alfredo Sauce,” was featured on “I Is For Italian,” a segment of the television show “WQED Cooks.” The alfredo sauce remains one of WQED’s most-requested recipes.
