"SHIRLEY STUTTLER" SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM ASHE FRANKLIN SECTION POLICY GUIDELINES COVERING

- The Shirley Stuttler Scholarship was named in 2020 in honor of Shirley who served on the Section and National Boards of ASHE for over 30 years and spent countless hours advocating for transportation in the counties covered by ASHE Franklin.
- The number and amount of scholarships will be determined by ASHE Franklin Board and the Scholarship Evaluation Committee annually. The scholarship(s) is(are) awarded annually to an applicant of good personal character who demonstrates satisfactory academic achievement and are looking to pursue a career in civil engineering, transportation/highway, trade school or related fields.
- The applicant must be a resident of OR attending a college/university/trade school located in Crawford, Erie, Forest, Mercer, Venango or Warren Counties, Pennsylvania.
- The applicant must be attending college/university/trade school (or high school senior planning to attend similar) with a civil engineering, transportation/highway, trade school or related fields course load.
- A Scholarship Evaluation Committee, comprised of at least three Section members, will evaluate all applications and determine the successful candidate.
- Scholastic achievement, application presentation, extra-curricular activities, community service, character and financial need will be considered by the Scholarship Evaluation Committee.
- For residents in above listed Counties, any approved curriculum in an accredited college or university or trade school within the United States of America will be acceptable. For others, approved curriculum in an accredited college or university or trade school within the Counties listed above will be acceptable.
- A scholarship recipient who interrupts his/her studies during the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded shall forfeit any balance. Exceptions are military duty or medical reasons.
- No one person can receive a scholarship twice.
