FAST FACTS

- In the past six debate seasons, Grove City College
 Debate has secured 12 national championship titles
 in Varsity, Junior Varsity and Novice tracks.
- In 2020 alone, the Varsity Debate team secured five national championship titles at the National Christian Collegiate Forensics Association's National Championship.
- In the past six debate seasons, four 1st place national championship speakers have emerged from Grove City College students.
- Coach-as-professor-as-mentor relationships are built and sustained in small-sized classes, keeping in line with our 13-1 student-faculty ratio.
- Grove City has one of the nation's first student-run undergraduate law journals: Journal of Law and Public Policy.
- Internship and career support is offered from our nationally-ranked Career Services Office.
- The Institute for Faith and Freedom is housed on campus and offers lectures, internships and critical analysis via policy papers throughout the year.
