Below is a checklist of the required forms to be returned to the health center.

Health Center Form Checklist:

2. Immunization Record (including meningitis vaccine) _____
3. Meningitis Vaccine Waiver if Declining _____
4. Consent for Treatment _____
5. Notice regarding GCC prospective student athlete, if applicable_____

Note: Routine physical exams are not done at the health center. Students participating in varsity athletics will have a pre participation physical for their sport done at the health center, but they must still have the health forms including the physical exam completed prior to arrival to campus.

FAILURE TO RETURN FORMS: Students who are missing these forms may have a “**Medical**” hold placed on their account, in which case they would not be permitted to register for classes, access grades or ask for transcripts.

In addition to physician services, students may receive treatment for minor illnesses and injuries. Over the counter medications, hot and cold packs, crutches and other orthopedic supplies, first aid and wound care supplies are available at no additional cost to the student. There is a variety of health- related educational literature and resources available at the Health Center for student use.

It is mandatory that all entering students have a pre-admission physical examination by his or her family physician. It is also required that all mandatory immunizations are up to date.

Under Pennsylvania law, students must receive vaccination against meningococcal disease if they wish to live in a residence hall. Students must provide written proof of having received the vaccine from their health care provider. If a student chooses not to receive the vaccine based on medical, religious, or other strong beliefs, then a waiver must be signed. If the meningitis vaccine has already been given before the age of 16 a booster dose is recommended.

Consent for treatment is required for all students enrolled at the College in order to receive care at the Zerbe Health and Wellness Center. **If you will be under the age of 18 when you begin the school year then your parent or guardian must sign the consent for treatment of a minor form.**

We would again like to welcome you to Grove City College and look forward to assisting you in your health care needs.

Please return the forms no later than **August 1, 2022**. **Transfer students may obtain copies from their previous school and send.**
